PETITIONERS' MOTION FOR STAY

Pursuant to OSAH Rule 616-1-2-.17, Petitioners Georgia Interfaith Power and Light and Sierra Club move this Court to stay the deadlines in these proceedings for up to 43 days, by which time Petitioners anticipate withdrawing their request for a hearing in the above-captioned matter challenging a Permit Amendment issued to Telfair Forest Products LLC, No. 2499-271-0022-V-05-2.

On September 4, 2024, Petitioners filed an Amended Petition for Hearing alleging that EPD's issuance of the Permit Amendment was procedurally and substantively invalid as a matter of law.

On October 23, 2024, EPD notified Petitioners that it had formally revoked the Permit Amendment challenged in this action, effective immediately. *See* Exhibit 37. EPD explains, "As

per [Telfair's] request, [the Permit Amendment] is hereby revoked in its entirety, effective immediately." *Id.* The May 2021 Permit (No. 2499-271-022-V-05-0) remains in force.

EPD's revocation of the Permit Amendment does not become legally final for 30 days. Telfair has the right to challenge EPD's revocation of its Permit Amendment within 30 days, by filing a Petition for Hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings. *Id.* EPD does not anticipate Telfair will challenge this revocation. *Id.*

Before the conclusion of the requested stay, Petitioners plan to move this Court to withdraw their request for a hearing if the Permit Amendment revocation is finalized. Thus, Petitioners request that the deadlines in this action are stayed for up to 43 days—through December 6, 2024—or until the Petitioners move this Court to withdraw their request for a hearing, whichever comes first. This will allow 30 days for the Permit Amendment revocation to become legally final and up to 13 days for the Petitioners to file a motion to withdraw their request for a hearing.

Alternatively, if Telfair does choose to appeal EPD's revocation of the Permit Amendment, the Parties will have 13 days following the appeal deadline to confer and propose to the Court the best course forward in this action.

Therefore, Petitioners ask this Court to grant its motion to stay these proceedings for up to 43 days, or until Petitioners ask to withdraw their hearing request, whichever comes first.
